



Professional Service Provider Recognition Program Frequently Asked Questions

Q. What is the Professional Service Provider Recognition Program?

A. The Professional Service Provider Recognition Program is a recognition program that acknowledges someone who goes above and beyond to help support individuals with Prader-Willi Syndrome whenever possible...a PWS champion!!

Q. Who can be nominated for the Professional Service Provider Recognition Program?

A. Any professional who provides services to an individual with PWS in the state of Wisconsin. This could include medical, clinical, therapy, education, and direct support staff.

Q. How can I nominate someone?

A. PWSA-WI, Inc. members can obtain an application at pwsaofwi.org or by emailing a request for an application to progdir@pwsaofwi.org. Completed applications can be submitted via mail, email, or Facebook.

Q. Can I nominate myself?

A. We apologize, but no self-nominations are accepted for this award.

Q. Can someone be nominated more than once?

A. Once a nomination application has been received, the nomination will carry over from application period to application period. There is no need to resubmit another nomination.

Q. How is a winner chosen?

A. A committee comprised of at least 3-4 PWSA-WI, Inc. Board Members will review and approve all applications. The nominee's place of employment will be notified an award has been granted to a professional service provider and a presentation of the award will be scheduled.

Q. What does the winner receive?

A. The winner will receive a framed certificate along with a \$50 gift card.

Q. What is the deadline for a nomination and where do I submit my nomination?
